

### Cultivar description

<b>Harvest time</b>	Junebearer, low chilling type, earlier than 'Malling Centenary', early as 'Clery', but earlier with the main harvest
<b>Reference cultivars</b>	'Malling Centenary', 'Clery', 'Rendezvous'
<b>Fruit size</b>	High percentage first class fruit, large to medium: average 21g – 35g
<b>Fruit appearance</b>	Glossy fruit, very attractive, vermillion red
<b>Fruit firmness</b>	Firm
<b>Shelf life</b>	Very good scores, glossy also after storage
<b>Flavour</b>	Very pleasant, fresh-fruity, balanced sugar-to-acid ratio, no drift, stable also after storage, good mouthfeeling
<b>Yield</b>	High (higher than 'Malling Centenary'), in substrate 550-600g/plant in early cultivation in greenhouse (Tray)
<b>Picking</b>	Very easy
<b>Plant habit</b>	Compact but vigorous, open habitus
<b>Resistances</b>	Healthy plants, no obvious susceptibility to diseases, more resistant to root diseases than 'Malling Centenary'
<b>Cultivation system</b>	Greenhouse, tunnel, raised bed, substrate on table tops, not in the open field (lower yield!), early tray plant production suggested
<b>Use</b>	Fresh market, early market
<b>Pedigree</b>	P-120279 × 'Malling Centenary'
